Even if a dog has earned an OTCH/RAE from AKC, that dog would have to begin at the Novice B level in ASCA Rally. Any dog that has previously earned any obedience and/or Rally title must be entered in the B class to earn titles.

**Obedience Awards:** Flat ribbons awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> - 4<sup>th</sup> place in Regular classes. Green qualifying ribbons will be awarded for qualifying scores. Rosettes each day for HIT, HIT Aussie, High Combined and High Scoring Junior Handler. Non-regular classes will be awarded flat ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup> - 4<sup>th</sup> places.

**Rally Awards:** Flat ribbons will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> - 4<sup>th</sup> place in classes. Green qualifying ribbons will be awarded for qualifying scores and special X Qualifying ribbons for those earning scores of 195 and above. Rosettes awarded for HIT, HIT Aussie, High Combined in Excellent/Masters and High Scoring Junior Handler.

**Attention Exhibitors:** The shows will be judged and run under the show rules for the Australian Shepherd club of America. Dogs must be ready for judging. No refunds will be given for dogs absent, disqualified, excused or barred from exhibiting by the show committee. Refunds will be given up to the close up the pre-entry deadline. Substitutions may be made with dogs owned by the exhibitor. No entry which specifies any condition as to its acceptance will be accepted. No electrical or mechanical training devices are allowed on the show grounds. Entries must be made on official ASCA entry forms.
